l'âme de fond

The name of this project is called 'l'âme de fond'. This technique allows Philippe to capture a calm, serene yet mysterious world. The images are minimalistic and allows the viewer to open a door to the imagination because it provides the freedom to allow each individual to record their own history and interpretation.

Between 2006 and 2008 he concentrated on this one body of work. To create the desired effects he used a film camera with a square format and black and white film.

With the camera on a tripod and using long exposures he perfected his technique during two long years. His dedication of capturing these images, traveling through Switzerland and France, resulted in a balanced folio mix of waterscapes and landscapes.

In November, 2008, 25 images of this series were exhibited in the Fnac Lausanne, and then traveled to the Spaziophotographica Gallery in Locarno.

The photograph "Emergence" nos 134 was selected by the fine art photographic magazines, Croate BULB Magazine in last February 2008. Philippe is a member of the collective, '8 Reg ART' who specialise in fine art photography and during October 2008 held an exhibition with the 8reg'art collective to present Fine Art style in France.



Philippe was born in Paris, France but made his home in Switzerland, where he works as a freelance photographer. He did his photographic training and study in Geneva.
